This could include research, policy, or practice, but must include evaluation of outcome data. The deadline for poster submission is 17th January 2018. All presenters are required to register as a delegate by 31st January.

Your abstract submission should contain a title, all author names and affiliations, and a structured abstract of no more than 250 words. For completed work the structure should be – Background, Method, Results, Discussion. For ongoing work it should be – Purpose, Background, Method, Discussion.
